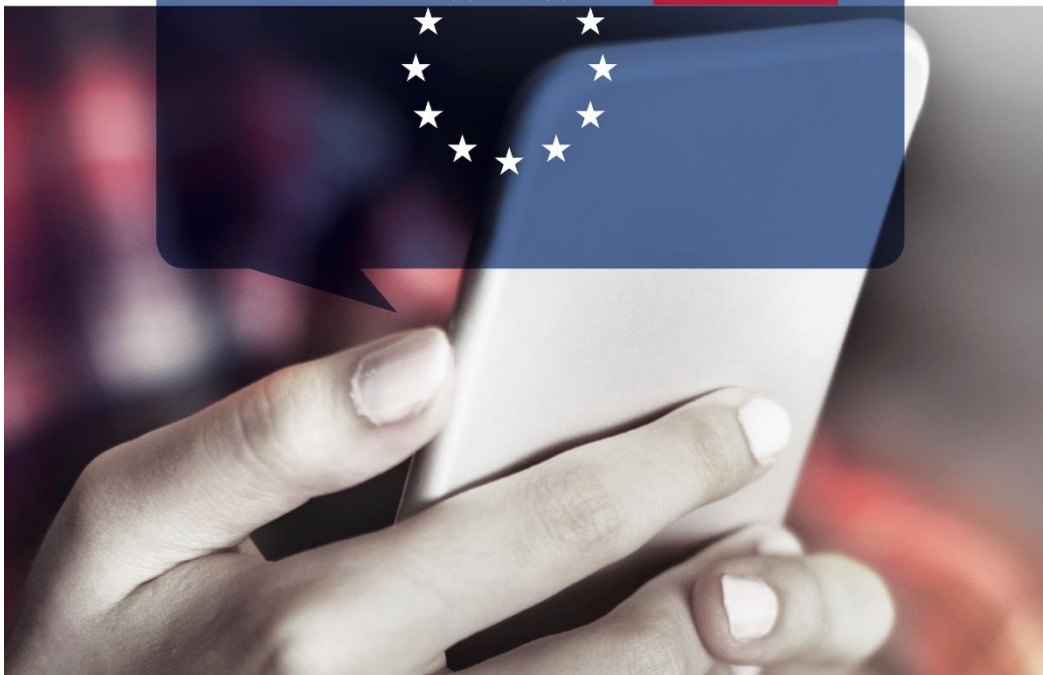

1. Background and objectives

The Foundation will be established in July, 2017 by Éditions Lefebvre Sarrut S.A. (ELS), Europe's second largest legal publisher.

The purpose of the Foundation is, in the public interest and without an aim for profit, to address the need of information for immigrants and foreigners arriving in Europe, especially the youth and elderly, and help them through the administrative journey related to immigration by simplifying access to the law, provide means and measures for the above, and thus to increase the well-being and create a better everyday life for the human beings immigrating into the EU.

Europe attracts families, entrepreneurs, students and all those looking for an economically and politically stable place to live. Everyone should be able to easily access the laws that govern the country they move to, whether their stay is a temporary or more long-term one. The Foundation wants to centralise this information and facilitate both its access and its practical interpretation.

ELS as founder, is pursuing this goal of producing content that combines quality and pragmatism.

Europe is a place of welcome, education and development. The Foundation believes in the freedom to choose where one lives, while showing mutual respect for each other.

The Foundation is a non-profit organisation and although initiated/supported by ELS/Sdu Uitgevers B.V., is born from a pure charitable motive and is strictly separated from any commercial offering by ELS/Sdu Uitgevers B.V..

2. Activities and policy

The Foundation strives to realize its objectives through the creation, development and online publication of a Mobile Immigration Guidance, a comprehensive solution dedicated to the legal rights of immigrants and foreigners.

3. Envisaged projects

In order to achieve the objectives, the Foundation has been committed to the project of establishing the Immigration Guidance App:

A native application

- For smartphones and tablets
- Compatible with Apple iOS and Android systems
- Available free of charge

- Accessible in English, French, German, Spanish and Dutch
- For use in various European countries

A uniform application

- Responses to frequently asked questions
- Check-lists, diagrams and forms
- Videos, addresses and useful links

All you need to know to complete the initial immigration procedures

- Preparing an asylum application
- Obtaining a long-term residence permit
- Obtaining a work or study permit
- Relocating
- Preparing an application for family reunification
- Obtaining a temporary residence permit

4. Organization

The Management Board of the Foundation (the "Board") decides on grants by the Foundation and meets at least two (2) times a year, usually in The Hague.

The Board consists of:

- Sdu Uitgevers B.V.; the Dutch subsidiary of the founder ELS
- Sabine Matheson; Vice-Chairman of the Supervisory Board of ELS
- Liesbeth Hop; Directeur Nationale Academie voor Media & Maatschappij is seen as one of the Dutch authorities on media literacy. She is a media expert with the mission to improve the media literacy of youth, parents, teachers, corporate companies and governments and has a background in media, communication

and public affairs.

The Board has full legal authority and responsibility for the conduct, affairs and activities of the Foundation in a manner consistent with the purpose of the Foundation.

The Board is charged with the management of the Foundation, and more in particular with the management and administration of the Foundation's means, the adoption of the budget of income, including distributions and funds to be made available in view of the realization of the Foundation's objectives. The Board is entitled to accept (and refuse) donations on behalf of the Foundation. No donations shall be accepted which are made under conditions contrary to the objectives of the Foundation.

The Board is responsible for the financial position of the Foundation and its results. The Board is required to keep record of the financial position of the Foundation and its activities - including all of its financial transactions, revenue and expenses - and keep the relevant records, documents and other data carriers in such a way that as a result at any time the rights and obligations of the foundation are shown.

The Foundation is assisted by a secretary who takes care of the books and records of the Foundation. Furthermore the secretary handles the administration and files, and takes minutes of meetings of the Board.

5. Source, management and destination of Funds

The Foundation will seek to obtain contributions and grants from a variety of sources.

ELS has committed to an investment of € 20.000,- that will be granted to the Foundation upon obtaining the ANBI status

It is very difficult to forecast with any certainty the amounts of contributions that the Foundation will receive. In 2017, the Foundation hopes to receive € 75.000,- from the public to be able to launch the Immigration Guidance App. In years thereafter the Foundation expects to receive around € 20.000,- to maintain and improve the App.

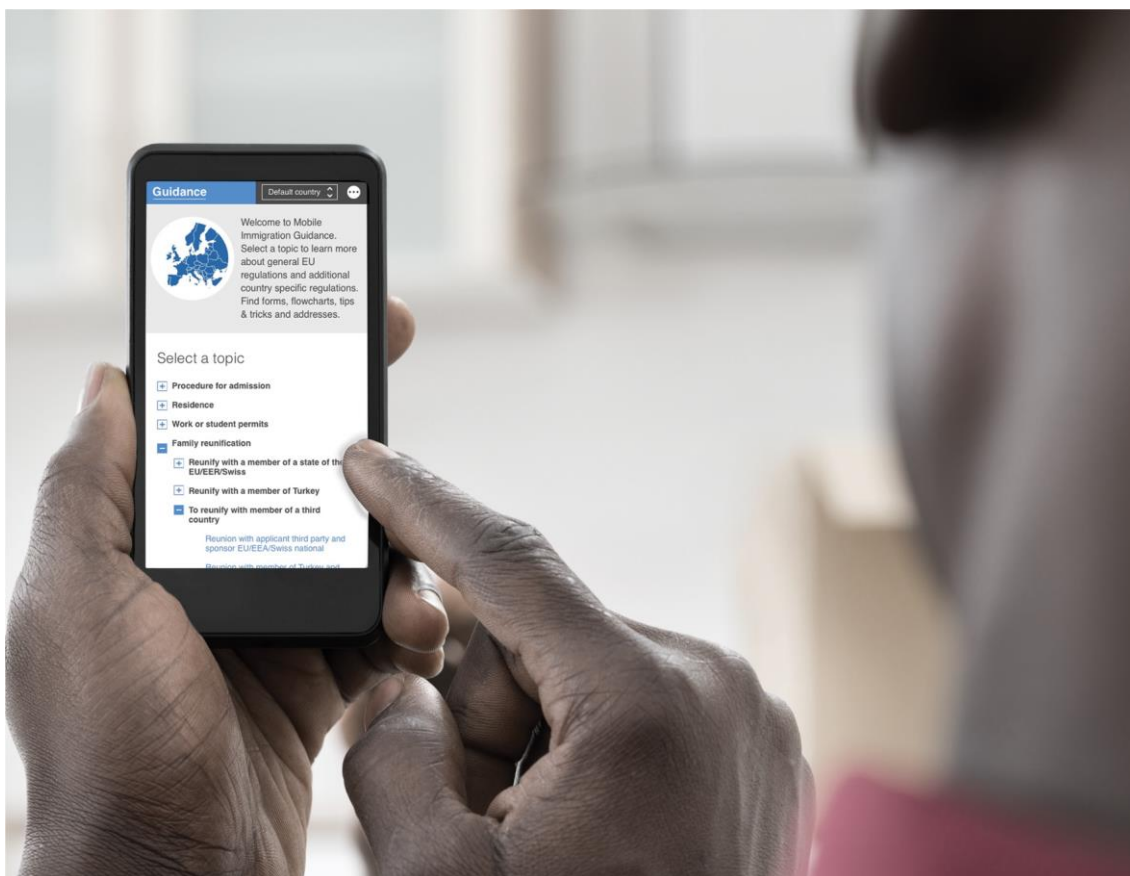
All administrative costs are kept on a reasonable level in order to grant as much money as possible to the cause. Less than 5% of the Foundation's income is spent on administration.

Members of the Board don't receive a remuneration for the activities performed by them as such.

The Foundation shall not have more financial means than to the judgment of the

Management Board is necessary to secure the continuity of the activities for the benefit of its objects.
